To Whom It May Concern:

In my capacity as Staff-Sgt. Marc Moreau, Course Operations, at the Technological Crime Learning Institute, Canadian Police College and a member of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police at the time, I can verify that Mr. Arnold Villeneuve authored and instructed information technology network security related courses for our government organization. These courses lasted two weeks in length. Mr. Villeneuve was an Author and Instructor with the Canadian Police College between 1998 and 2002 or about 4 years. The attendees for these courses included law enforcement officers from all three levels of government (municipal, provincial, and federal) and security personnel from various Government of Canada departments including Military Police from the Department of National Defense.

Mr. Villeneuve authored and instructed the following courses for the Canadian Police College (and has taught them many times over these years):

- NetWare Networking – Introduction and Security Forensics
- Windows Server Networking – Introduction and Security Forensics

In particular, Mr. Villeneuve introduced Law Enforcement Officers to the basics of local area networks but more importantly he showed them how to recover user accounts and passwords when investigating information technology (workstation and server) based crimes in situations where they were not receiving cooperation from the individuals being investigated. The course also explained to the Attendees how to identify who had access to important files and folders that were deemed to be part of the investigation to ensure the investigation is not compromised and only authorized personnel had access to them.

I consider Mr. Villeneuve's capabilities in the area of information technology systems and security to be of superior expertise, above and beyond what would normally be encountered from others in his field. His ability to actually teach the concepts of

information technology are also superior above and beyond what other people in the field would have because as not every technology specialist or even an expert is able to instruct a course on the topics they know very well and teach it so that even highly technical details are understood by the audience. His efforts have significantly raised the level of understanding among the Law Enforcement and Security Officer personnel attending the CPC courses in question and helped contribute to their ability to leverage their new knowledge to better fight crime in the future.

It is without reservation that I validate Mr. Villeneuve experience and top expertise within the information technology security field of practices.
